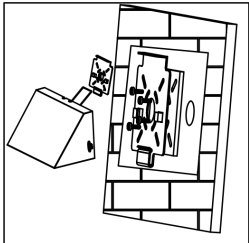
### PRE - INSTALLATION

- Carefully remove the fixture from the carton.
- Before beginning assembly, installation, or operation of product, make sure all parts are present. Compare parts with package contents list and diagram on previous page. If any part is missing or damaged, do not attempt to assemble, install or operate the product. Contact customer service for replacement parts.
- Tools required for assembly (Not Included): screwdriver, phillips screwdriver, pliers, electrical tape, wire cutters, safety glasses, ladder, wire stripper.

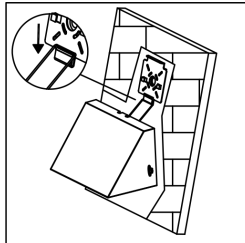
### WARNING

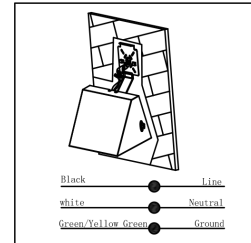
## INSTALLATION (Caution: Before beginning installation turn off the circuit breaker and light switch)



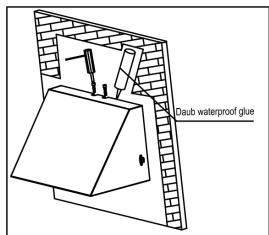
**STEP 1**  
Remove the lamp and hook from the mounting plate and fix the mounting plate and waterproof foam on the wall.



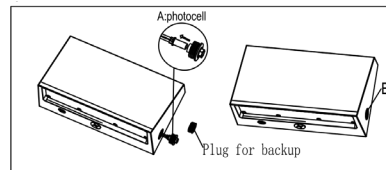
**STEP 2**  
Hang the lamp on the mounting plate.



**STEP 3**  
Connect the AC line of the lamp.



**STEP 4**  
After hanging the lamp on the mounting plate and tightening the screws, and put a waterproof glue seal between the bottom cover and wall to prevent water from entering the lamp.



**STEP 5**  
If the user feels that the light control probe exposed by the bulge of the lamp is not beautiful and does not need the light control function, you can unscrew the light control plug as shown in Figure A. Pull out the probe black rubber plug inside the plug and put it back into the lamp to replace the spare flat plug and tighten, as shown in figure B
