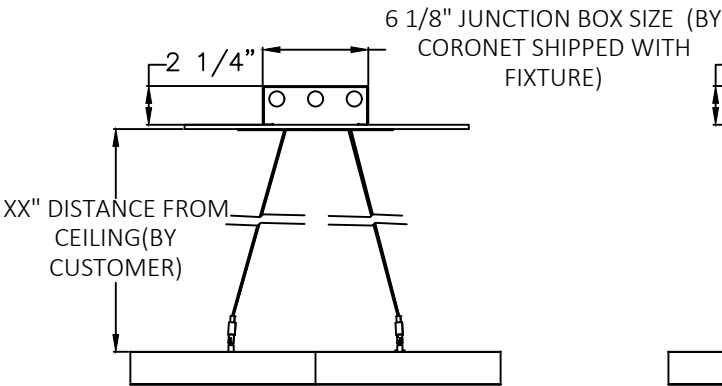

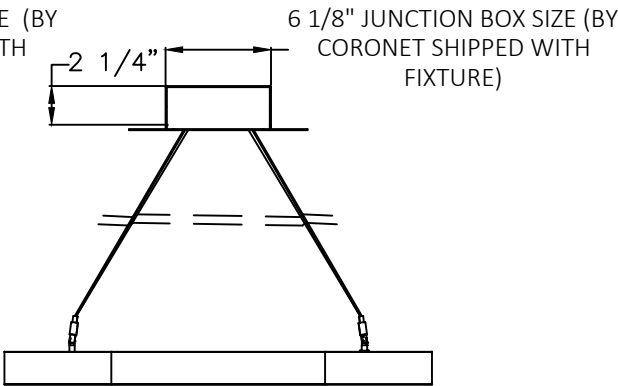

SIDE VIEW



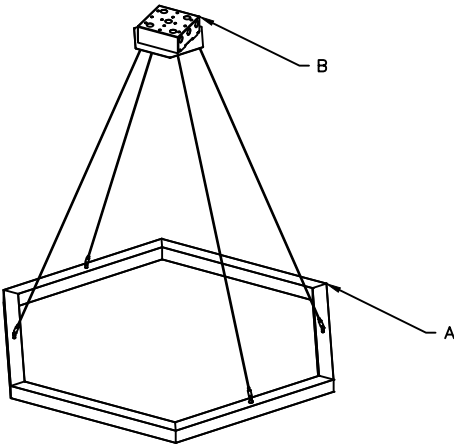
FRONT VIEW



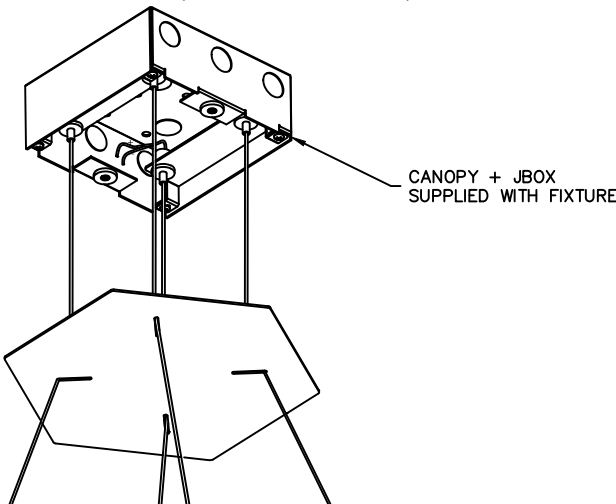

CUZTOM CANOPY DETAIL(CENTER OF FIXTURE)



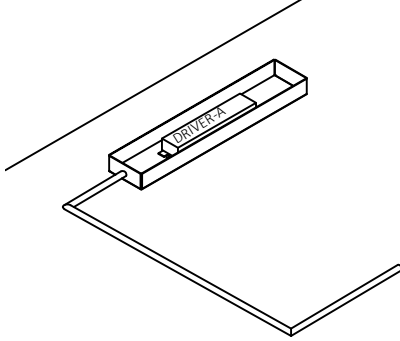

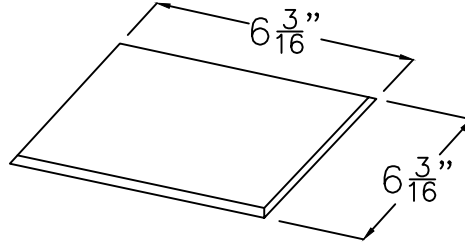
1 WIRING TO REMOTE BOX



Install driver box on ceiling and run conduit (do not remote >30ft apart).

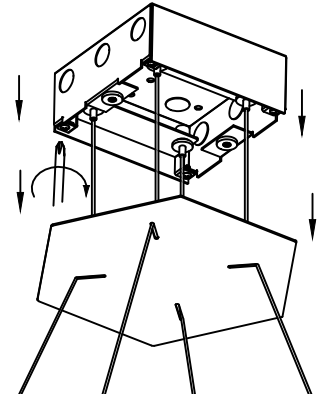
Note: Use whips or plenum rated wires from junction box to remote box.

2 Ceiling cutout for Junction Box



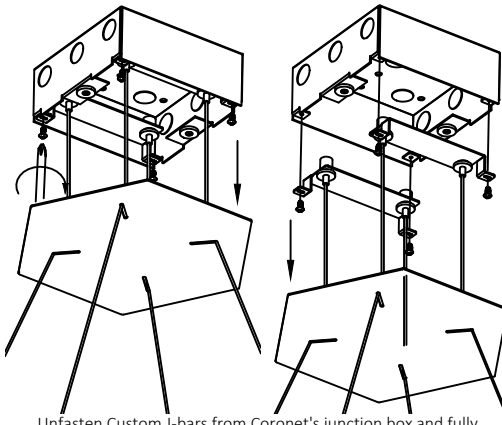
Create a ceiling cutout for Coronet's 6x6" junction box.

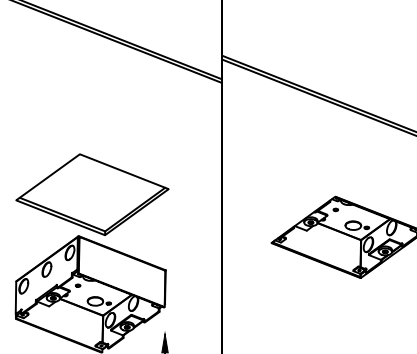
Bring down canopy plate from fixture.

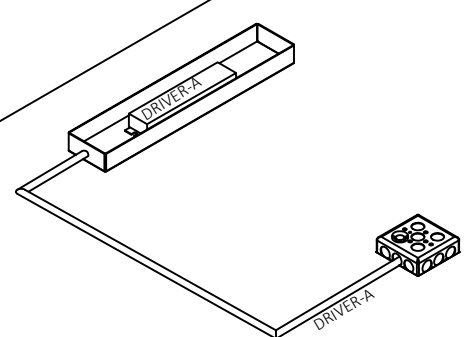
Unfasten Custom J-bars from Coronet's junction box and fully detached Coronet's junction box

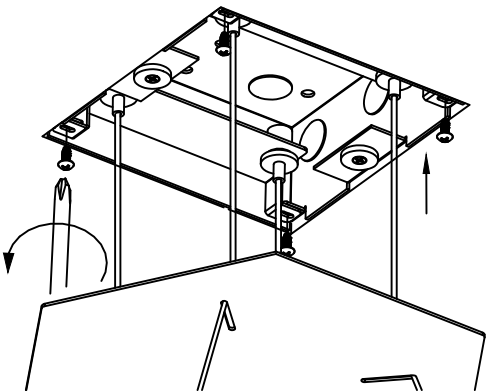
Install junction box into ceiling.

Insert remote drivers whip into Coronet's junction box.

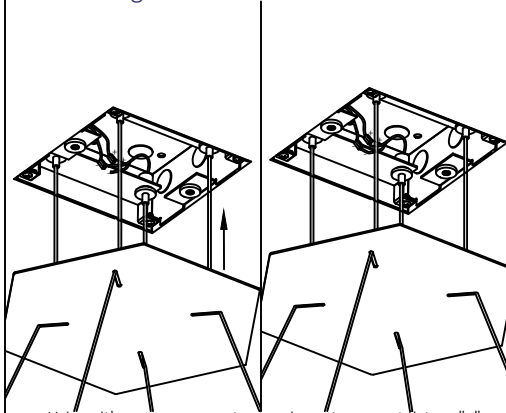


Bring up and secure J-bars into junction box.

Note: two or more people must be holding the fixture while working.

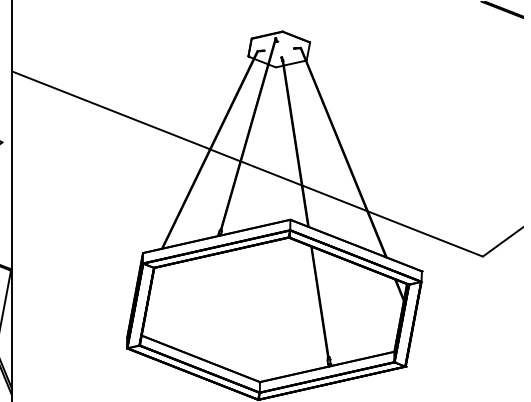

8 Wiring



Using either wago connector or wire nut, connect fixture "+" lead wire to Conduit "+". Do the same for "-" lead wire.

At last, bring up Custom Canopy plate and turn on fixture.



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GENERAL INSTALLATION CONSIDERATIONS - See submittal drawings for job specific data.

Operating Temperature.....-20°C to 40°C
Operating Voltage.....110VAC-277VAC, 50Hz-60Hz
Weight.....lb
Dimensions.....See submittal drawings

- Installation by a certified electrician only.
- Read and understand the installation instructions before attempting to install or use the fixture.
- Only use fixtures with voltage for which it is rated. Do not exceed the specified voltage and current input.
- Do not use the fixture if the housing, lens, or power cable is damaged.
- Ensure that the main power supply is off before installing or wiring the fixture.
- Method of wire connection to be determined by local electrical codes and regulations.
- The external flexible cable of this luminaire cannot be field replaced; if the cord is damaged, contact Coronet.
- The light source contained in this luminaire shall only be replaced by the lighting manufacturer or his service agent or a similar qualified person.
